### **1951**

- These were the first General Elections under Universal Adult Suffrage in St. Vincent and the Grenadines. All adults over the age of 21 were eligible to vote.
- There were two parties: The Eighth Army of Liberation, led by George Charles, and the Working Men's Association, led by George Mc Intosh.
- The Eighth Army of Liberation won all 8 seats at stake in the elections.

### **1954**

- The second Elections in the era of Universal Adult Suffrage.
- The party that won the majority of seats (3 of the 8 seats at stake) was the People's Political Party (PPP) led by Ebenezer Joshua. Five Independent Candidates were also successful and they formed a coalition Government led by George Charles.

### **1961**

- First General Elections under the Advanced Constitution- Greater Internal Self Government
- The number of parliamentary seats increased from eight to nine.

### **1972**

- First General Elections after the granting of Statehood in Association with Britain.
- First General Elections after the State was divided into 13 constituencies.
- First General Elections after the voting age was reduced from 21 years old to 18 years.
- First General Elections which ended in a tie. The two major political parties, St. Vincent Labour Party and People's Political Party each won six seats. The independent candidate James Mitchell won the Grenadines seat. He joined the PPP in a coalition Government of which he became Premier and leader in Parliament.

### **1974**

- These were the fourth General Elections in just over eight years (August 1966-December 1974) and the second in two and a half years (April 1972-December 1974).
- This particular election was the result of the passing of a resolution of 'No Confidence' in the coalition Government led by James Mitchell.

### **1979**

- These were the first General Elections after St. Vincent and the Grenadines became an Independent Nation. The State had been granted Independence from Britain 39 days previously on October 27<sup>th</sup>, 1979.

### **1980**

- First Post-Independence By-Election. This was a result of the resignation of the representative for the Grenadines, Cosmos Cozier.

## **1984**

- These were the first General Elections held under the Representation of the People Act 1982.
- This was the first time that house-to-house enumeration was undertaken. This method prevented non-residents and non-existing electors from being added to the list of electors.
- It was the very first time that voters were issued Identification Cards.

## **1989**

- The number of constituencies was increased from 13 to 15 by the Act No. 21 of 1989.
- The incumbent New Democratic Party (NDP) won all fifteen seats equaling the achievement of the Eighth Army of Liberation in 1951.

## **2001**

- The elections were called early due to wide spread protest and civil unrest. Under the supervision of Caricom, the Grand Beach Accord was signed by the Government and the Opposition Party Leader, setting the stage for General Elections.
- Monitors from the Commonwealth Secretariat, the Organization of American States, Caricom, Human Rights Watch of Barbados, the SVG Christian Council and the National Monitoring and Consultative Mechanism observed the Elections.

## **2009**

- A Referendum on a revised Constitution for St. Vincent and the Grenadines was held on 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2009.

## **2010**

- First General Elections since the staging of the Referendum for a revised Constitution.

## **2015**

- Two petitions were filed in the courts by the NDP challenging the results in the constituencies of Central Leeward and North Windward.

## **Miscellaneous**

- There have been 17 General Elections and 6 By-Elections between 1951 and 2015.
- Political Independence from Britain was attained in 1979 and there have been 9 General Elections between then and 2015.
- There were two general Elections in which the victorious Party, in terms of seats won, received minority votes.
  1. 1966 (PPP – 48.6% with 5 seats: SVLP – 49.86% with 4 seats)
  2. 1998 (NDP – 45.15% with 8 seats: ULP – 54.4% with 7 seats)

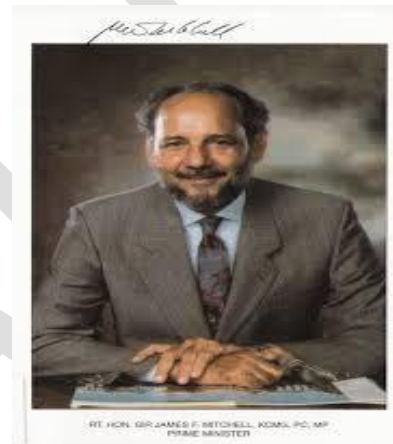
