INTRODUCTION

On Saturday, 7th November 2015, Dr. The Hon. Ralph E. Gonsalves, Prime Minister of St. Vincent and the Grenadines and Leader of the Unity Labour Party (ULP) announced at a meeting of his party that General Elections in St. Vincent and the Grenadines would be held on Wednesday, 9th December 2015, and that Nomination Day would be Friday, 20th November 2015.

Besides the Unity Labour Party (ULP), three (3) other political Parties contested the polls:

- (i) The Democratic Republican Party (DRP) led by Mrs. Anesia Baptiste
- (ii) The SVG Green Party (GP) led by Mr. Ivan O'Neal
- (iii) The New Democratic Party (NDP) led by Hon. Arnhim Eustace

The Parliament of St. Vincent and the Grenadines had on Thursday, 28th May 2015 passed a Bill to amend Section II of the Representation of the People Act No. 7 of 1982 to allow the Electoral Office to remove from the Voters' List the names of all persons who had not updated their voter registration since 1st June, 2005. The one (1) month special registration period granted under the Amendment to the Act for persons to update their registration expired on 31st July, 2015. As a result of this Amendment, the Voters' List published in August 2015 showed a total of 86,041 eligible registered voters when compared with the Voters' List published at the end of the previous quarter that recorded 106,801 active voters.

With this major hurdle having been crossed, the Electoral Office focussed its attention on ensuring that the locations selected as polling stations met the minimum standards that are internationally accepted, especially with regard to access for the elderly and incapacitated voters. All potential polling stations were visited and assessed. Where the location was unacceptable, an alternative venue was selected.

While there were evidently other areas in which more work could have been done, e.g. voter education, the Electoral Office was satisfied that it was sufficiently prepared to execute a successful poll. The initial feedback from the local monitoring team and the overseas observer missions suggest that the outcome of the elections reflects the will of those who voted on 9th December 2015.

The New Democratic Party (NDP) which won seven (7) of the fifteen (15) seats contested has, however, maintained that there were irregularities in the process. An application by the NDP Candidate for Central Leeward, Benjamin Exeter to have the ballot boxes removed from the care of the Supervisor of Elections was heard by Justice Brian Cottle on Tuesday 22nd December, 2015. The application was dismissed.

On Thursday 31st December, 2015 the NDP filed two (2) petitions in the Court challenging the results in the constituencies of Central Leeward and North Windward. As this report is being prepared, there has been no hearing of or resolution to the matter.

Mr. Ivan O'Neal also unsuccessfully challenged the Supervisor of Elections in the Court regarding the time advertised for receipt of Nomination papers by prospective candidates in the 9th December 2015 General Elections.

There are, undoubtedly, areas in which the local election management practices need be strengthened. The Electoral Office appeals to all stakeholders in the electoral process, primarily the legislators, to cooperate to achieve the necessary enhancements.

PRE-ELECTION ACTIVITIES

On Monday, 9th November 2015, the Governor General His Excellency Sir Frederick N. Ballantyne G.C.M.G issued the Proclamation dissolving the Parliament of St. Vincent and the Grenadines. His Excellency on that day also issued Writs of Election to the fifteen (15) Returning Officers authorizing them to conduct the nomination of candidates and if necessary, to cause a poll to be taken on 9th December 2015.

In addition, His Excellency declared Tuesday, 10th November to Monday, 23rd November 2015, as the period for Special Voter Registration.

The *Notice of Nomination*, the *Notice of Election*, the *Notice of Places where Preliminary Voters' Lists Would Be Displayed* and the *Notice of Grant of Poll* were all gazetted and printed in the local newspapers as required by law.

The *Preliminary Voters' Lists* were published and distributed to the Returning Officers for display at the places earlier advertised. Printed and electronic copies of the *Preliminary Voters' Lists* were also distributed to all four (4) political parties.

Nomination Day

The Returning Officers and their Election Clerks received a total of forty three (43) nominations on Nomination Day. This number represented a full slate of fifteen (15) candidates from the New Democratic Party (NDP) and the Unity Labour Party (ULP); seven from the SVG Green Party (GP) and six (6) from the Democratic Republican Party (DRP).

Special Voter Registration

The Special Voter Registration period which ended on Monday, November 23rd 2015, again proved to be a most challenging exercise for all stakeholders in the process.

The registration of voters was closely monitored by political parties most noticeably the New Democratic Party (NDP) and Unity Labour Party (ULP). Mainly because of the support provided by the Royal St. Vincent and the Grenadines Police Force, the environment at the registration centres was relatively peaceful.

The statistics show that between November 10th and November 23rd, a total of 1916 individuals updated their registrations or registered for the first time; 539 were new registrants: 307 males and 232 females.

Final Voters' List

The Final Voters' List was published on Saturday, 28th November 2015. The printed and electronic versions were distributed to all Returning Officers and Political Parties on Wednesday 2nd December 2015.

There were 89,527 registered electors on the List. The number of registered electors in the 13th December, 2010 General Elections was 101,053, and in the 7th December, 2005 General Elections 91,069.

GENERAL

The Electoral Office collaborated with the staff of the IT Support Department (ITSD), Ministry of Telecommunications in June to provide an electronic Voters' List, accessible on the government website. This initiative was implemented for the special registration in July and continued through to the special registration period in November. In addition, the ITSD staff designed and installed a Polling Station Finder on the government website www.gov.vc that allowed voters to locate the polling station at which they were registered to vote, complete with a photograph of the polling station. These initiatives appeared to have been welcomed by voters, politicians and the wider public as the Electoral Office received very favourable feedback.

Two (2) new polling stations were added to the two hundred and twenty-nine (229) used in the 2010 General Elections. In South Leeward - Polling Station A1 and in East St. George- Polling Station C2 were created since in both polling divisions that existed previously the total number of registered voters was in excess of 700.

The training of election officials was a significant element of the preparations for the 9th December poll. With only two (2) changes to the List of Returning Officers who had served in the 2010 General Elections, the task of training the election officials was easy to execute. As in 2010, the Electoral Office benefitted from the services of a cadre of very experienced, highly motivated and extremely dedicated Returning Officers. Additionally, more than 50% of the election officials who agreed to serve in 2015, had prior experience in at least one (1) of the last three (3) General Elections held in St. Vincent and the Grenadines.

The Supervisor of Elections attempted to meet during the pre-election day period with all the major stakeholders in the process and to address any significant issues they had highlighted. Closer to Election Day, meetings were held with the National Monitoring and Consultative Mechanism, as well as the Observer Missions from CARICOM, the Commonwealth and the Organisation of American States.

The procurement, preparation and timely distribution of election materials required a high level of organization and coordination on the part of the Electoral Office. However, thanks to the diligent and determined efforts of the staff of the Electoral Office, the distribution of election material was completed by 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday 8th December, 2015.

ELECTION DAY

The two hundred and thirty-one (231) polling stations nation-wide opened at 7:00 a.m. on Wednesday, 9th December 2015. Reports from the Returning Officers suggest that there was a steady flow of voters during the morning session. This situation prompted allegations of slow voting in certain constituencies. However, as the day wore on, the voting lines decreased considerably in size, and consequently the earlier complaints of slow voting.

The Returning Officers also reported a relatively quiet day of voting. Instances of confrontation between opposing parties were quickly diffused by the police whose presence was evident at the polling stations and in the various communities.

On Election Day, the Supervisor of Elections responded to six (6) queries from persons whose names were not on the Voters' List. Only two (2) of these cases had merit; their names had been inadvertently omitted from the Final Voters' List. The other four (4) individuals had failed to update their registration over the last ten(10) years and their names had therefore been removed from the Voters' List.

The Supervisor of Elections also received eight (8) letters of complaint from the legal firm of Equity Chambers which represented the New Democratic Party (NDP). Four (4) complaints were about slow voting in the constituencies of West St. George, Marriaqua and Central Kingstown. The other complaints were:

- i. Incident at Polling Station F1 – Central Leeward
- ii. ULP Candidate allowed to remain in Polling Station beyond maximum time – Central Leeward
- iii. Political Campaigning being broadcast on VC3 TV
- iv. ULP Polling Agents canvassing and advising persons on who to vote for

The polls closed at 5:00 p.m. and in most polling stations, the Presiding Officers were able to proceed with the Preliminary Counting of Ballots shortly thereafter. When all the Preliminary Counts were completed, the results indicated that NDP had won in seven (7) constituencies and the ULP in eight (8) constituencies. Neither the Democratic Republican Party (DRP) nor the SVG Green Party (GP) had secured a victory.

The results show that 65,706 or 73.4-% of the 89,527 eligible registered voters had cast a ballot on Election Day.

POST-ELECTION ACTIVITIES

The Final Count was conducted in all fifteen (15) constituencies on Thursday, 10th December 2015. The result at the end of the Final Count was consistent with that of the Preliminary Count.

It is worth noting here that the Supervisor of Elections made a decision to assist with the Final Count in the North Leeward constituency, based on the result in that constituency where Mr. Roland Matthews had received 2,259 votes and Mr. Carlos James 2,252 votes, and where there were 20 rejected votes. The Supervisor of Elections consequently journeyed to Chateaubelair on the morning of Thursday 10th December to oversee the Final Count in the North Leeward constituency. This final count was witnessed by both candidates and their representatives. When all fifteen (15) ballot boxes were counted, Mr. Matthews had increased his tally of votes to 2,267 and Mr. James to 2,255. The difference between their total votes was 12 after the Final Count as against 07 in the Preliminary Count. The Final Count in North Leeward was conducted in a cordial atmosphere and at the end of the day's proceedings which ended at about 7:30 p.m., both parties expressed satisfaction with the outcome.

All Writs of Election were received from the Returning Officers at the conclusion of the Final Count. The Supervisor of Elections subsequently presented the fifteen (15) Certificates of Endorsement to His Excellency the Governor General.

CONCLUSION

The Supervisor of Elections commends all the election officials for ensuring that free and fair elections were once again conducted in this nation, and re-iterates that the results of the 9th December 2015 General Elections reflect the will of those electors who voted.

Serious consideration, however, needs to be given to a comprehensive review of the Representation of the People Act No. 7 of 1982 to address the following areas, among others:

- i. The registration of political parties**
- ii. The qualifications of a voter**
- iii. The Special Voter Registration**
- iv. The number of registered voters per polling station**
- v. The format and relevance of all documents used in the election process, especially those to be completed after the close of poll**
- vi. The use of digital devices by voters e.g. cell phones and tablets at polling stations on Election Day**
- vii. The use of social media for campaign purposes on Election Day**
- viii. The role and function of the agents of political parties, in particular the 'outside' agents**
- ix. The unsightly painting of campaign information on public and private property, particularly those in close proximity to polling stations**
- x. Detailed instructions regarding the sealing of ballot boxes**
- xi. Voting by election officials and police officers ahead of polling day**
- xii. The official announcement of election results**
- xiii. The role and function of election observers**
- xiv. The creation of an independent Electoral Management Body**

Equally important in the thrust towards continuing the tradition of free and fair elections in St. Vincent and the Grenadines is the need to strengthen the staff of the Electoral Office so that a vibrant and relevant Voter Education Programme could be implemented and sustained between General Elections.
